Additional Backup Information

This agreement is for the rental renewal of 10 multi-function document imaging machines for Austin Water Utility Department. These machines will function as network printers, copiers, scanners and fax machines. Total cost includes supplies (with the exception of paper), maintenance, delivery and training.

This Cooperative purchasing program was established as a national structure for local government agencies to make use of their collective purchasing power and is authorized under the provision of the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Chapter 791 Texas Government Code. This 12-month rental agreement between the City of Austin and Xerox Corp. was awarded Sept 1, 2009 in an estimated amount not to exceed \$43,219.23. This recommended Council action is to approve Amendment No. 1 to enter into a 12-month option period in the amount not to exceed \$55,949.52, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$99,168.75.
