Additional Backup Information

The City of Austin was granted water and wastewater certificates of convenience and necessity (CCNs) in November 2004 by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ). Austin Water has discovered that certain customers are located in the City's CCNs, but are being provided utility service by another utility. This is because until the advent of Geographic Information System tools, the TCEQ historically used less precise methods to determine the boundaries of a utility's CCN. These customers have already paid plan review, engineering, inspection, impact, and tap fees to their utility service provider.

The customer at 11600 Manchaca Road is currently served by Aqua Texas and the customer at 15829 North I.H. 35 is currently served by Manville Water Supply Corporation. Austin Water requested, and those utilities agreed, to transfer those customers to the City. Because the customers already paid the above-mentioned fees to the other utility, Austin Water is requesting a waiver of these fees.
