Authorize award and execution of Amendment No. 5 to a contract with 360TRAINING.COM, INC., Austin, TX for the purchase of North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC) certification web based training for Austin Energy's Energy Control Center (ECC) and Energy Marketing Operations (EMO) to exercise the third 12-month extension option in an estimated not to exceed \$13,899.28 with one additional 12-month extension option in an estimated amount not to exceed \$70,303.12.

Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$13,899.28 is available in the Fiscal Year 2010-2011 Operating Budget of Austin Energy. Funding for the remaining extension option is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

This contract will provide Transmission Operator (TO) and Reliability Operator (RO) certifications from the North American Reliability Corporation (NERC) for 20 Austin Energy Electric System Controllers. These employees control the electric grid via Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) and respond to system emergencies.

After certifications are obtained, NERC requires Continuing Education Hours (CEHs) every three years to maintain them. The TO certification requires 140 hours and the RO certification requires 200 hours (every three years). There are several sources from which CEHs may be obtained including the Electric Reliability Council of Texas (ERCOT) and Austin Energy. Austin Energy provides some in-house training, as a NERC CEH Provider, but does not have a full-time trainer to develop all of the required hours. This contract will allow for the remaining hours needed to be purchased from 360Training.com, an online NERC CEH Provider.

This contract was competitively bid and awarded in 2008. Funding in the amount of \$32,992.56 for administrative increases and for exercise of the first and second 12-month extension options was added administratively. The recommended Council action is to approve Amendment No. 5 in the amount of \$27,899.28, and the authorization to enter into the final option period when appropriate, for a total estimated contract amount not to exceed \$70,303.12.
