Authorize negotiation and execution of an amendment to the professional services agreement with each of the following five (5) firms: ESPEY CONSULTANTS, INC., Austin, TX; ATKINS NORTH AMERICA, INC., Austin, TX; HDR ENGINEERING, INC., Austin, TX; FREESE AND NICHOLS, INC., Austin, TX; CHAN & PARTNERS ENGINEERING LLC, INC., (MBE/MA) Austin, TX for the 2007 General Watershed Continuing Engineering Services Rotation List, in the amount of \$1,000,000 in additional authorization, for a total not to exceed amount of \$10,000,000 for this rotation list. This additional authorization will be allocated as follows: ESPEY CONSULTANTS, INC., \$195,000; ATKINS NORTH AMERICA, INC., \$40,000; HDR ENGINEERING, INC., \$140,000; FREESE AND NICHOLS, INC., \$225,000; and CHAN & PARTNERS ENGINEERING LLC, INC. \$400,000.

Amount and Source of Funding

Funding is available in the Capital and Operating budgets of the departments for which services are needed.

Additional Backup Information

In 2006 the Watershed Protection Department (WPD) identified a number of engineering projects which address the primary missions of the watershed protection program: water quality protection, flood mitigation, and stream erosion stabilization and restoration. On January 25, 2007 nine engineering firms were selected with a total authorization amount of \$9,000,000, with \$1,500,000 for the top three ranked firms, \$1,000,000 for the second three and \$500,000 for the remaining three firms. To date, all nine firms on the 2007 General Watershed Continuing Engineering Services rotation list have received two or more project assignments with \$8,391,600 (93.2%) contracted. A total of 27 project assignments were made before a replacement rotation list (2011 Watershed Flood Hazard Mitigation Engineering Services) was initiated in December, 2010.

The 2007 rotation list is closed to new assignments; however there are several on-going projects which require additional authorization to allow their completion. The initial scope of work for many of the projects did not anticipate related improvements that were requested such as water, wastewater and design changes. The added scope was included in order to increase project delivery efficiency and reduce public inconvenience during the construction phase.

The following projects require additional contract authority to enable their continuation and completion: Shoal Creek Allandale Storm Drain Improvements, Boggy Creek MLK TOD Stormdrain Improvements (Freese & Nichols Inc.); Williamson Creek – Blarwood Storm Drain Improvements, Shoal Creek Rosedale Phase 2 Storm Drain Improvements (Espey Consultants Inc.); Town Lake – Waller Creek Renicek Field Water Quality Retrofits (Atkins N.A. Inc.); Slaughter Creek David Moore Drive Creek Crossing Improvements (HDR Engineering Inc.); and Nueces Street Storm Drain Improvements and Little Shoal Creek Tunnel Realignment (Chan & Partners Engineering Inc.).
