Approve a resolution authorizing the acceptance of \$48,360 in grant funding from the State of Texas, Governor's Office, Criminal Justice Division to implement the Austin Police Department project entitled APD Anti-Gang Strategies and Programs. Related to Item # 40.

Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$48,360 is available from the State of Texas, Criminal Justice Division, Title V Program for the project period of May 1 – August 31, 2011. An in-kind match of 10% is required and will be met by accounting for the salary of an existing city-funded APD Joint Juvenile Gang Intervention Unit detective.

Additional Backup Information

This action will provide the resolution required by the Criminal Justice Division to complete the award process related to \$48,360 in grant funding. The project is entitled "APD Anti-Gang Strategies and Programs" and the project period is May 1 – August 31, 2011.

Title V funds will be used to build the capacity of the department to provide casework services to high at-risk and adjudicated gang-involved youth. Funds will be allow for the continued grant-funded salary of a gang coordinator and for the purchase of project related equipment and supplies.

The grantor requires a resolution approved by council that addresses items one through four below.

1. Authorization by your governing body for the submission of the application to CJD that clearly identifies the name of the project for which funding is requested;
2. A commitment to provide all applicable matching funds;
3. A designation of the name and/or title of an authorized official who is given the authority to apply for, accept,

reject, alter, or terminate a grant (Note: If a name is provided, you must update CJD should the official change during the grant period.); and

4. A written assurance that, in the event of loss or misuse of grant funds, the governing body will return all funds to CJD.
