This request allows for the development of an agreement with a qualified proposer that Council selects. If the City is unsuccessful in negotiating a satisfactory agreement with the selected proposer, negotiations will cease with that provider. Staff will return to Council so that Council may select another qualified proposer and authorize contract negotiations with this provider.

The Retiree Dental Program provides City retirees an opportunity to purchase dental coverage for themselves and their dependents. This coverage is paid for solely by the retiree.

This solicitation gave vendors the opportunity to submit proposals for a Dental Maintenance Organization (DMO) and a Preferred Provider Organization (PPO) dental plan. The evaluation committee recommends continuing the current dental plan arrangement by offering retirees the Assurant DMO and Delta Dental's PPO dental plan. The term of these contracts is from January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2014 for the initial period. The one-year extension options, if exercised, will extend the term through December 31, 2017.

The evaluation panel consisted of professional and managerial staff from the Human Resources Department, Employee Benefits Division. They are experts in the industry and recommend these two plans as the best proposed plans offering reasonable rates and good benefit design. In addition, the recommended awardees have excellent references and many years experience in providing these plans.
