This contract will provide replacement fire hose and equipment that will be used on all City of Austin fire apparatus. Various diameter fire hoses (1 ³/₄", 2″, 2 ¹/₂" high rise, 3″, and 5″) will be used to combat residential, commercial, and wild land grass fires. Approximately 12%-14% of fire hoses are replaced each year due to normal wear and specific damage incurred while fighting fires. Other firefighting equipment covered under this contract include firefighting hand tools, replacement thermal imaging camera batteries, nozzles, adapters, and other fire hose fittings.

In order to determine the best value to the City, evaluation criteria included cost and the number of line items bid.
