The owner of the needed property interests is HFH INVESTMENTS, LP, SUCCESSOR IN INTEREST TO TURNERSVILLE DEVELOPMENT, LTD. The property is located north of F.M. 1327, west of Bradshaw Road, and east of IH-35, in Austin, Travis County, Texas.</p>

Additional Backup Information

The southern area of the City of Austin's Extraterritorial Jurisdiction (ETJ), specifically along and east of I-35, is currently experiencing significant development. At this time water and wastewater utility infrastructure is not in place to handle this development. Austin Water Utility has developed the South IH-35 Water & Wastewater Infrastructure Improvements Program Project to address the anticipated needs for both water and wastewater infrastructure in this area.

Design plans for the South IH-35 Water & Wastewater Infrastructure Improvements Program Project require the acquisition of permanent waterline easements, temporary working space easements, and temporary staging and material storage site easements on the property located north of F.M. 1327, west of Bradshaw Road, and east of IH-35, in Austin, Travis County, Texas.

The City of Austin has attempted to purchase the necessary easements. The City and the property owners are unable to agree on the value of the needed acquisitions. The Law Department is requesting authorization to file an action in eminent domain on behalf of the City of Austin.
