ANALYSIS / **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:** Fleet Services is receiving \$240,000 for the ARRA-Propane Conversion Grant (Transportation Energy Efficiency Alternative Fuels and Technology Stimulus Grant). The entire grant award is appropriated in the fiscal year of the grant's start date. The General Fund will not be required to contribute to this grant. The Department of Energy through the Railroad Commission of Texas awarded the City of Austin \$240,000 in grant funds. These funds will be used to convert 60 existing City vehicles used by Aviation, Austin Energy, and Austin Water for propane use. These vehicles currently are fueled by unleaded gasoline.
