The request for the vacation of a 0.482 acre tract out of the S.P.R.R. Co. Survey, Abstract No. 750 and the W.M. Preece Survey, Abstract No. 2470, being a portion of that certain 0.543 acre tract conveyed to the City of Austin by Street and Utilities Deed, recorded in Document Number 2004091614 has been submitted by Katrina McDonald, Land Development Project Manager, DR Horton on behalf of Continental Homes of Texas, L.P.

The area being requested for vacation was originally dedicated for access for the site, but is no longer needed as part of the new site plan. All affected departments and franchise holders have reviewed this request and recommend approval. Property owners within 300 feet of the area to be vacated were notified on August 10, 2010. One objection was received by the Office of Real Estate Services.
