The City's Historic Preservation Office applied for and was awarded a grant from the National Park Services' Preserve America program. The grant provides funding for continued development and implementation of the Webbased Historical Survey Web tool project. The Historic Preservation Office is working with the University of Texas' School of Architecture. The grant provides \$87,278.00 in grant funds that will be matched by \$87,835.00 in staff time from City of Austin Historic Preservation staff and University of Texas faculty, staff, and graduate research assistants.

The scope of the project includes implementing use of the Web-based Historical Survey Tool to identify and upload information on historic properties located in the area of Austin east of IH-35.

The interlocal agreement between the City of Austin and the University of Texas stipulates that in-kind contribution will not exceed \$87,835, with the City providing \$19,760 and the University providing \$68,075.00 in accordance with requirements of the Preserve America Grant.
