This action would authorize the City of Austin to enter into an agreement with Travis County through which the City of Austin would accept and administer the 2011 Justice Assistance Grant Program (JAG) on behalf of the City of Austin and the Travis County Sheriff's Office (TCSO). Funding in the amount of \$393,697 is available from the Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance for the Justice Assistance Program. The Interlocal Agreement will remain in effect for the period October 1, 2011 through September 30, 2015. From the total grant allotment, the City of Austin will receive \$295,273, and Travis County will receive \$98,424. The City of Austin and Travis County will enter into this Interlocal Agreement so the City can serve as the fiscal agent for the JAG grant funding. The City of Austin will use its portion of the grant funding for equipment and supplies for sworn personnel.
