#### Subject

Authorize award and execution of a contract through the Texas Local Government Purchasing Cooperative (BuyBoard) with STANLEY CONVERGENT SECURITY SOLUTIONS, INC., Austin, TX, for the purchase and installation of electronic access and security systems for the new Animal Shelter in an amount not to exceed \$130,000.

Funding is available in the Fiscal Year 2010-2011 Capital Budget of the Austin/Travis County Health and Human Services Department through the 2006 Bonds.

### Additional Backup Information

This contract is for the purchase and installation of electronic access and security systems for the new animal shelter currently under construction at the Betty Dunkerley Campus. These systems will provide electronic access to various shelter buildings, burglar/intrusion detection, video surveillance, and monitoring of the fire alarm system. The new shelter is scheduled to open in November 2011.

The BuyBoard contract pricing is 12% lower than the pricing provided in the current contract.
