Authorize award and execution of a 24-month requirements supply contract with POWER SUPPLY, Austin, TX for the purchase of 200 Pelco Spectra 4 IP Digital Cameras for the Transportation Department in an amount not to exceed \$141,613 with two 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$70,806.50 per extension for a total contract amount not to exceed \$283,226.

Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$141,613 is available in the Fiscal Year 2010–2011 Operating Budget (2010 Bond) of the Austin Transportation Department, Traffic Signal Division. Funding for extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

Additional Backup Information

Austin Transportation Department is in the process of replacing their existing central traffic signal control system with a new Advanced Traffic Management System (ATMS); and is upgrading the communication network. In conjunction with the new ATMS, new digital CCTV cameras are needed. It is anticipated that fifty cameras will be purchased annually for the life of this contract.

The existing (analog) CCTV cameras are approximately 10 years old and have reached the end of their useful life. Additionally, their analog technology has become obsolete and does not utilize Internet Protocal (IP) communication technology used in new systems, including the new ATMS. The new CCTV cameras being purchased are digital cameras and are compatible with the new ATMS and the communication network without requiring additional analog to digital conversion hardware.
