Additional Backup Information						
The Uniform Plumbing Code provides a national standard for Plumbing installations. The proposed ordinance amends the currently adopted local amendments to create consistency within the technical codes and to improve water conservation and create a positive environmental impact.						
Highlights of the local amendments include:						
 Creating consistency with installation of water heaters. Adding an exception for the installation of hose bibbs on rain water. Prohibiting the use of potable water for once through cooling of commercial equipment. Elevator discharge containment system for improved environmental protection. Requiring self closing metered faucets to improve water conservation. Water closets average consumption of water of a maximum of 1.28 gallon per flush.
