BUDGETWORKSESSION MEETING WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 17, 2011

The City Council of Austin, Texas convened in a Council Special Called Meetingon Wednesday, August 17, 2011, 301 W. Second Street, Austin, Texas.

Mayor Leffingwell called the meeting to order at 9:07 a.m.

 Approve a resolution adopting a maximum proposed property (ad valorem) tax rate of 48.32 cents per \$100 taxable value that the City Council will consider for Fiscal Year 2011-2012; and setting the date that the Council will adopt the Fiscal Year 2011-2012 property (ad valorem) tax rate (suggested date is Monday, September 12, 2011 at 9:00 a.m.). (Public comment will be allowed on this item.)
 Resolution No.20110817-001 adopting a maximum proposed property (ad valorem) tax rate the City Council will consider for Fiscal Year 2011-2012 of 48.32 cents per \$100 taxable value was approved on a roll call vote on Council Member Spelman's motion, Council Member Riley's second on a 7-0 vote.
