STATEMENT: Please provide the decision being appealed and the specific grounds for the appeal. If specific grounds are not provided appeal will not be considered valid:

The decision being appealed is the denial by staff of our application for an Outdoor Music Permit under the provisions of Ordinance 20110210-029. We are appealing the denial on the grounds that 1) we believe we are entitled to an approval under the language of the ordinance, 2) we do not believe that the ordinance requires a Certificate of Occupancy for an OMV permit to be granted to a site and 3) we have not requested or applied for a principal use as an Outdoor Entertainment Facility and so this is not a fact that should be relevant to the denial of our permit. Our OMV Permit application was recommended for approval by the Music Office in their report after a site visit and research.
