## Additional Backup Information

The Uniform Mechanical Code provides a national standard for mechanical construction for commercial structures. The proposed ordinance amends Section 308 of the local amendments under Section 25-12-133, to create consistency with the Electrical Code.

Highlights for the draft ordinance are as follows:

- Equipment requiring electrical connections greater than 50-volt (roof top air units, exhaust fans)
- Requires a factory supplied disconnect within sight of unit (25 feet if greater than 120-volts).
- Receptacle on same level as equipment for safety purposes.
- Will create consistency with the electrical code.

These changes in the local amendments have no impact on housing affordability.
