Authorize award and execution of Amendment No. 2 to a contract with WHEELED COACH, Winter Park, FL, for the purchase of repair parts for ambulance light fixtures for Fleet Services, to extend the contract for one 12-month period in an amount not to exceed \$35,000 for a revised total estimated contract amount not to exceed \$140,000.

This contract is used by Fleet Services to purchase repair parts for the interior light fixtures of City ambulances.

This contract was competitively bid and awarded in 2008 for a 24-month base period in the amount of \$70,000 with two 12-month extension options. Amendment No. 1 was issued in October 2010 to exercise the first 12-month extension option in the amount of \$35,000. This recommended Council action is to approve Amendment No. 2 for \$35,000 for the final 12-month extension option, for a final contract value of \$140,000.
