**ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:** As outlined in Resolution No. 021003-40, Council Member Martinez has agreed to apply \$289 to his fee waiver allocation budget, Council Member Morrison has agreed to apply \$289 to her fee waiver allocation budget and Council Member Riley has agreed to apply \$289 to his fee waiver allocation budget. Additionally, the \$100 refundable damage deposit requirement is also being waived. Any fee requirements above this total are the responsibility of the applicant.

Waiving fees for this event results in unrealized revenue for the General Fund, Parks and Recreation and Austin Police Departments, and Transportation Fund, Austin Transportation Department. Although budgeted revenue for fees is based upon historical data and not necessarily upon specific events, the waiver of these fees reduces potential revenues that could be realized.
