# Subject

Authorize award and execution of a 36-month requirements service contract with ACE FIRE EQUIPMENT CO., INC., Austin, TX, or one of the other qualified bidders for IFB-BV No. PAX0210, for fire alarm and fire suppression maintanance and repairs at Convention Center facilities in an estimated amount not to exceed \$910,000, with three 12-month extension options in estimated amounts not to exceed \$432,000 for the first extension option, \$518,400 for the second extension option, and \$622,080 for the third extension option, for a total estimated contract amount not to exceed \$2,482,480.

# Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$250,000 is available in the Fiscal Year 2011-2012 Operating Budget of the Austin Convention Center Department. Funding for the remaining 24 months of the original contract period and extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

# Additional Backup Information

This contract is for inspection, testing, maintenance, and repair of the fire alarm and fire suppression systems located at the Austin Convention Center, Palmer Events Center, and Convention Center parking garages. The contract will provide basic maintenance services for scheduled monthly, semi-annual, and annual inspections, as well as maintenance and repairs on an as-needed basis. Services provided under this agreement will comply with all applicable City of Austin and National Fire Protection Association guidelines as they relate to maintenance, repair, and inspections of life safety systems.

In order to determine the best value to the City, evaluation criteria included the labor rate and cost of materials.

This request allows for the execution of a contract with a bidder, who provides the best value to the City, that Council selects. If this bidder does not execute a contract with the City, staff will return to Council so that Council may select another best-value bidder and authorize a contract with this bidder.
