Prior Council Action:	October 11, 2007 - Approved an amendment to the Advance Funding Agreement with Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) that allows the City to construct the Lance Armstrong Bikeway in TxDOT right of way; January 11, 2007 - Authorized the negotiation and execution of an Amendment to the Advance Funding Agreement with TxDOT to allow TxDOT to build the easternmost segment of the Lance Armstrong Bikeway and for the City of Austin to pay \$70,300 towards the cost of the easternmost segment; October 26, 2000 - Approved the Interlocal Agreement between the City of Austin and TxDOT for the Austin Crosstown Bikeway (later renamed the Lance Armstrong Bikeway) grant awarded by the Statewide Transportation Enhancements Program in the amount of \$3,203,163.63; July 15, 1999 - Approved a list of City of Austin Transportation Enhancement Applications.

<p>This project will consist of an off-street, 10 foot wide concrete bicycle trail from the intersection of East 5<sup>th</sup> and Shady Lane to the existing Airport Boulevard Bridge over the Colorado River. The bicycle crossing of Cesar Chavez at Lavender Loop will be improved as part of the project.</p> <p>Due to the potential for changes when working in TxDOT ROW with TxDOT coordination and oversight, a 10% contingency has been included to allow for the expeditious processing of any change orders.</p> <p>The contract allows 210 calendar days for completion of this project. This project is located within zip code 78702 and is managed by the Public Works Department.</p>
