

SPECIAL CALLED MEETING FRIDAY, OCTOBER 7, 2011

The City Council of Austin, Texas convened in a Special Called Meeting on Friday, October 7, 2011, City Hall at 301 W. Second Street, Austin, Texas.

Mayor Leffingwell called the meeting to order at 1:35 p.m.

Mayor Leffingwell recessed the Council Meeting to go into Executive Session at 1:37 p.m.

The Mayor announced that Council would discuss items number 1 and 2 on the regular agenda during Executive Session.

The Executive Session ended and Mayor Leffingwell called the Council Meeting back to order at 2:14 p.m.

- Approve an ordinance ordering an election to be held in the City of Austin on May 12, 2012 to elect the mayor and three council members.
  - Ordinance No. 20111007-001 was approved on Council Member Spelman's motion, Council MemberMorrison's second on a 4-3 vote. Those voting aye were: Mayor Pro Tem Cole and Council Members Morrison, Spelman and Tovo, Those voting nay were: Mayor Leffingwell and Council Members Riley and Martinez.
- Approve a Resolution authorizing a November 2012 general election date. (Notes: SPONSOR: Mayor Lee Leffingwell CO 1: Council Member Mike Martinez CO 2: Council Member Chris Riley)

The Mayor ruled this item out of order due to the adoption of No. 1.

Mayor Leffingwell adjourned the meeting at 3:16 p.m. without objection.

The minutes for the special called meeting of October 7, 2011 were approved on this the 20th day of October 2011 on Council Member Spelman's motion, Council Member Martinez' second on a 6-0 vote. Mayor Pro Tem Cole was absent.
