Additional Backup Information						
The 82nd Texas Legislature recently amended several sections of Article 45.056 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure in favor of further integrating juvenile case managers into the juvenile justice system. One of the amendments to this state law mandates that the governing body of a municipality, employing juvenile case managers at its court, to adopt reasonable rules for juvenile case managers. The rules must address the following: (1) a code of ethics, and for the enforcement of the code of ethics; (2) appropriate pre-service and in-service training standards; and (3) training in various areas specified by the 82nd Texas Legislature. Since the City of Austin employs juvenile case managers at its Court, the City Council must adopt these rules by December 1, 2011 to comply with state law. The Court is thereafter responsible for implementing the rules adopted by the City Council.
