ANALYSIS / **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:** This Grant Agreement will allow the City to use Texas Traffic Safety Funds to purchase and distribute an additional \$10,200 worth of front and rear bicycle light sets, which will include an informational card about bicycle safety and the legal requirements for using lights when riding a bicycle at night. The proposed outcome of the grant is to increase public information and education efforts on bicycle safety, while also decreasing the number of motor vehicle-related bicycle fatalities. The City of Austin in-kind match of \$3,336 will be provided through volunteer hours (assembly and distribution). The General Fund will not be impacted from accepting this grant.
