**ANALYSIS** / **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:** The City of Austin Art in Public Places (AIPP) program of the Cultural Arts Division, Economic Growth & Redevelopment Services Office sought to commission a professional visual artist /artist team to design, fabricate and install a work of art to contribute to the new Asian American Resource Center, being constructed at the intersection of Cameron Road and U.S. Highway 183.
