## PROPERTY DESCRIPTION FOR PARCEL 39

DESCRIPTION OF 0.999 OF ONE ACRE (43,530 SQ. FT.) OF LAND OUT OF THE LUCAS MUNOS SURVEY NO. 55, ABSTRACT NO. 513, IN AUSTIN, TRAVIS COUNTY, TEXAS, SAME BEING ALL OF THAT CERTAIN TRACT OF LAND DESCRIBED AS 0.9992 OF ONE ACRE IN PROCEEDINGS IN EMINENT DOMAIN IN PROBATE COURT NO. 1, CAUSE NO. 1602, TO THE CITY OF AUSTIN, OF RECORD IN VOLUME 10718, PAGE 1417, REAL PROPERTY RECORDS, TRAVIS COUNTY, TEXAS, SAID 0.999 OF ONE ACRE OF LAND BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED BY METES AND BOUNDS AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING at a 1/2" iron rod found in the existing south right-of-way (ROW) line of U.S. Highway 290, 2.23 feet left of Engineer's Baseline Station 385+20.35, at the northwest corner of the herein described tract, same being the northwest corner of said City of Austin tract, same being the northeast corner of that certain tract of land described as 1.985 acres in a deed to JW 290, LTD., of record in Document 2004224690, Official Public Records, Travis County, Texas, also being in the south line of that certain tract of land described as 4.233 acres in deeds to the State of Texas, of record in Volume 3057, Page 1540 and Volume 3122, Page 1826, Deed Records, Travis County, Texas, from which point a TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (TxDOT) Type I concrete monument found in the north line of said JW 290 tract, the existing south ROW line of U.S. Highway 290, and the south line of said 4.233 acre State of Texas tract bears S84°02'10"W 94.25 feet;

1) THENCE, with the north line of this tract, and said City of Austin tract, same being the existing south ROW line of U.S. Highway 290, and the south line of said 4.233 acre State of Texas tract, N84°02'10"E, passing at 199.92 feet a 1/2" iron rod found, continuing 216.00 feet, in all a total distance of 415.92 feet to a calculated point, 2.27

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feet left of Engineer's Baseline Station 389+36.27, at the northeast corner of this tract, and said City of Austin tract, and the southeast corner of said 4.233 acre State of Texas tract, being at an angle point in the existing south ROW line of U.S. Highway 290, and in the west line of that certain tract of land described as 1.008 acres (Parcel B) in a deed to the State of Texas, of record in Volume 678, Page 613, Deed Records, Travis County, Texas, from which point a TxDOT Type I concrete monument found bears S05°57'50"E 1.79 feet;

2) THENCE, with the east line of this tract and of said City of Austin tract, the existing south ROW line of U.S. Highway 290, and the west line of said 1.008 acre State of Texas tract, S26°44'43"W 95.99 feet to a 1/2" iron pipe found, 78.50 feet right of Engineer's Baseline Station 388+84.41, at the southeast corner of this tract and said City of Austin tract, same being the southwest corner of said 1.008 acre State of Texas tract, and being in the north line of that certain tract of land described as "Old State Hwy 20" (Tract A) in a deed to the State of Texas, of record in Volume 871, Page 354, Deed Records, Travis County, Texas, and the existing north ROW line of Old State Highway 20;

THENCE, with the south line of this tract and said City of Austin tract, and the existing north ROW line of Old State Highway 20, and the existing north ROW line of said State of Texas "Old State Highway 20" tract, and continuing with a portion of Old State Highway 20 for which no record conveyance was found, as shown on TxDOT ROW map CSJ#0114-02-012, the following two (2) courses, numbered 3 & 4;

- 3) S73°45'15"W 240.04 feet to a 5/8" iron rod found, 121.37 feet right of Engineer's Baseline Station 386+48.22; and
- 4) S74°05'04"W 130.65 feet to a calculated point, 143.97 feet right of Engineer's Baseline Station 385+19.54, at the southwest corner of this tract and of said City of Austin tract, same being the southeast corner of said JW 290 tract, from which point a mag nail found to be replaced with a TxDOT Type II concrete monument after acquisition, 193.91 feet right of Engineer's Baseline Station 382+49.02, in the south line of said JW 290 tract, and the existing north ROW line of Old Manor Road, bears S73°34'59"W 275.09 feet;

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5) THENCE, with the west line of this tract and of said City of Austin tract, and the east line of said JW 290 tract, N05°38'24"W 146.20 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING and containing 0.999 of one acre within these metes and bounds, more or less.

All bearings are based on the Texas State Plane Coordinate System, Central Zone, NAD83(93) HARN. All distances and coordinates were adjusted to surface using a combined scale factor of 1.00011.
