The meeting was called to order with Mayor McClellan presiding.

Mayor McClellan stated that this was a Special Called Meeting for the purpose of publicly announcing that the Council would convene in a closed or executive session authorized by Section 2, Paragraph (g) of Article 6252-17, Texas Revised Civil Statutes Annotated, to interview applicants for Municipal Court Judges. After such closed or executive session, any final action, decision, or vote with regard to any matter considered in the closed or executive session be made in open session should such action, decision or vote be necessary for the appointment of Municipal Court Judges.
