

**RESOLUTION NO. 20111208-139**

**WHEREAS**, The Market on Collier, has filed an application for a waiver of Section 4-9-4(A) of the City Code which prohibits the sale of alcoholic beverages within 300 feet of a church, public school, or public hospital; and

**WHEREAS**, The Market on Collier, located at 1700 South Lamar Boulevard, Suite 230, Austin, Texas, is within 300 feet of the Siddha Yoga meditation center, located at 1700 South Lamar Boulevard, Suite 203; and

**WHEREAS**, notice of the application and hearing for the waiver was provided in accordance with Section 4-9-5 of the City Code; and

**WHEREAS**, a public hearing concerning this proposed waiver was held by the City Council on December 8, 2011, in accordance with the provisions of Section 25-1-132 of the City Code; and

**WHEREAS**, no written support or letter of opposition has been received from Siddha Yoga meditation center; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council, after consideration of the health, safety, and welfare of the public and the equities of the situation, has determined that the waiver request is in the best interest of the community; **NOW, THEREFORE**,


**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

The Market on Collier is granted a waiver from Section 4-9-4 of the City Code and is allowed to sell alcoholic beverages at 1700 South Lamar Boulevard, Suite 230, Austin, Texas; and the waiver shall expire on the sale

or transfer of the business to any other individual or entity, whether by lease or any other arrangement, on cessation of the business, or on revocation of the alcoholic beverage permits granted to The Market on Collier at this site.
