Approval of this action will authorize the Director of the Neighborhood Housing and Community Development (NHCD) Office, Betsy Spencer, to apply for grant funding in the amount of \$200,000 from the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs (TDHCA) Housing Trust Fund 2012 – 2013 Amy Young Barrier Removal Program. The Amy Young Program provides one-time grants of up to \$20,000 to Persons with Disabilities qualified as Low Income, for home modifications necessary for accessibility and the elimination of hazardous conditions.

TDHCA will utilize an online reservation system, in which grant recipients reserve and draw Project Costs and Administration Fees and track the status of the Program activities. Funds are available on a first come, first serve basis. Program funds are available until August 31, 2012 or until they are completely reserved.
