Authorize award and execution of a 36-month supply agreement with SUPERIOR CRUSHED STONE, Austin, TX, for flexible base for the Watershed Protection Department in an amount not to exceed \$222,750 with three 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$74,250 for each option, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$445,500.

Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$55,687 is available in the Fiscal Year 2011-2012 Operating Budget of the Public Works Department. Funding for the remaining twenty-five months of the original contract period and the extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

Additional Backup Information

Flex base is the material used to backfill excavations during the installation and repair of storm drain pipe by the Field Operations Division of the Watershed Protection Department. The material is stock piled in the Harold Court Service Yard, so it is always available for pipeline projects. The material is hauled to jobsites as needed and is replaced as it is used. Sufficient flex base is also stock piled for use during emergency response situations. This material is essential to perform storm drain pipeline work as it is the best backfill material available and is a proven commodity for this purpose.


