Consistent with the goal of preserving transportation corridors, the City of Austin is partnering with Travis County to update its methodology for determining fair and proportionate right-of-way dedications to be required in connection with development approvals. The goal of the project is to develop a model for determining infrastructure improvements that are roughly proportionate to the impacts of proposed development within the City of Austin, its extraterritorial jurisdiction, and unincorporated Travis County. Under the interlocal agreement, the City would retain Kimley-Horn and Associates to develop the model and be responsible for \$50,000 in costs, while the County would reimburse the City a total of \$25,000. The Travis County Commissioner's Court approved the Interlocal Agreement on July 5, 2011.
