<p>Consistent with the goal of preserving transportation corridors, the City of Austin is partnering with Travis County to update its methodology for determining fair and proportionate right-of-way dedications to be required in connection with development approvals. The goal of the project is to develop a model for determining infrastructure improvements that are roughly proportionate to the impacts of proposed development within the City of Austin, its extraterritorial jurisdiction, and unincorporated Travis County.</p> <p>Under the interlocal agreement, the City would retain Kimley-Horn and Associates to develop the model and be responsible for \$50,000 in costs, while the County would reimburse the City a total of \$25,000. The Travis County Commissioner's Court approved the Interlocal Agreement on July 5, 2011.</p>
