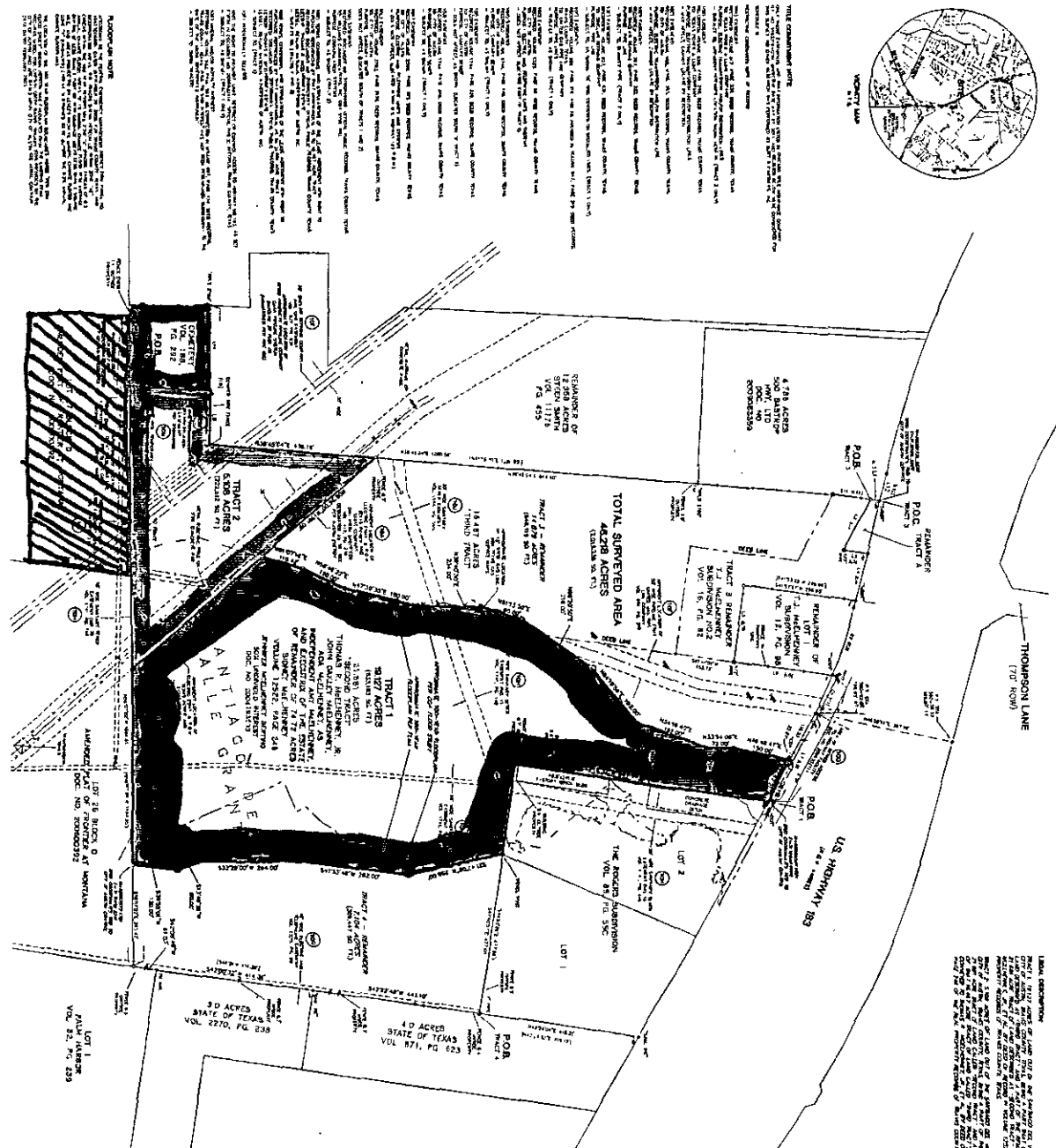
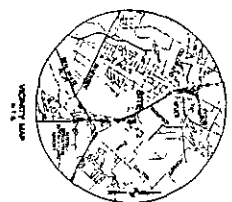

Case 1. A 32-year-old male, with a 10-year history of alcohol abuse, was admitted to the hospital with a 2-day history of severe abdominal pain, vomiting, and diarrhea. The pain was located in the right upper quadrant and was exacerbated by deep inspiration. The patient had a history of chronic liver disease and was on long-term treatment with alcohol. On admission, the patient was febrile, tachycardic, and had mild jaundice. Physical examination revealed tenderness in the right upper quadrant and a positive Murphy's sign. Laboratory tests showed elevated levels of aspartate aminotransferase (AST) and alanine aminotransferase (ALT), consistent with liver inflammation. A computed tomography (CT) scan of the abdomen showed a normal-sized gallbladder with no evidence of cholelithiasis or cholecystitis. The patient was treated with intravenous fluids, analgesics, and antibiotics. His symptoms improved over the next 48 hours, and he was discharged on oral painkillers and a low-fat diet. Follow-up CT scans at 1 and 3 months showed no significant changes in the gallbladder or surrounding tissues.
