Relevant Actions

SOC Action-15 (PRIORITY ACTION): Expand collaboration among law enforcement personnel and service providers of marginalized populations

CFS Action-15: Strengthen police ties to the community, including more personal interaction, to enhance safety and build trust.

CFS Action-16: Coordinate performance measures across public safety agencies to better plan for additional facilities, units, and staffing and to provide better oversight and service to all parts of Austin as the city grows.
