Mayor McClellan called the meeting to order, noting the absence of Councilman Goodman.

Mayor McClellan stated that this was an Emergency Special Called Council Meeting for the purpose of considering the following:

- 1. Taking a vote on the proposed property tax rate increase.
- 2. Setting a public hearing on the proposed property tax rate increase.
- 3. Publishing notices on the proposed property tax rate increase.

Regarding the "Notice of Public Hearing on Tax Increase," City Attorney Albert DeLaRosa stated that the Research & Budget Department had informed him that the City Manager's proposed budget called for a 7.67% tax increase. If the Council placed that percentage increase in the Notice, then that amount could not be exceeded.

#### <u>Motion</u>

Councilman Mullen moved the Council set the amount at 7.98%. Mayor McClellan seconded the motion.

### Substitute Motion

Councilman Duncan offered a substitute motion that the amount be set at 7.99%. The motion, seconded by Councilman Deuser, carried by a 6-0 Vote, Councilman Goodman absent. Council Memo
