On November 10, 2011, City Council approved the 2012 assessment rate for the District (at the current rate of \$0.10 per \$100 valuation), and approved the proposed 2012 assessment roll. Assessments on real property fund the PID services.

On December 8, 2011 the City Council conducted a public hearing on the proposed assessment roll. Approval of the assessment roll ordinance levying assessments and setting the method of collection and the rate of interest for late payments is the final Council action required in the annual process of approving PID assessments.
