Through AIDS SERVICES OF AUSTIN, approximately, 1,000 eligible patients will receive approximately 1,088 units of Oral Health services. One unit=One patient visit.

Through COMMUNITY ACTION, approximately, 76 unduplicated clients will receive approximately 635 fuel gas vouchers for travel to medical and dental appointments. Approximately 90 clients will receive approximately 1,084 units of direct transportation to their primary care appointments.

Through David Powell Public Health Center, approximately, 1,333 duplicated and unduplicated HIV positive clients will receive approximately 5,441 units of Ambulatory Outpatient Medical Care, CD4 test, Viral Load Test. One unit=One visit. Dispense prescriptions to 1,291 unduplicated clients eligible for reduce or-no-cost pharmaceuticals.

Through Communicable Disease, approximately, 21 eligible clients will receive approximately 2,200 units of Non-Medical Case Management. One unit=15 minute of Non-Medical Case Management.
