Mayor Mullen announced the purpose of the meeting is to consider a resolution authorizing the Chief of Police to provide emergency Austin Police Department assistance to Hitchcock, Texas.

Chief Dyson said he had received a written request from Hitchcock over the weekend ant it was re-verified this morning. Chief Dyson also stated that the officers agreed to go to Hitchcock on their own time to aid in the disaster, but Chief Dyson asked the Council to give them compensation time.

Councilmember Spaeth said to give the officers compensation time.
