8. Update on Austin Connects. (John Speirs and Lainie Duro) (wp3)

John Speirs and Lainie Duro with Skillpoint Alliance gave an update on Austin Connect a partnership between the City of Austin and Skillpoint alliance for the purpose of connecting local government, non-profits, educational institutions, corporations and citizens who have an interest in Community Technology. Austin Connects provide information and opportunities for local professionals in support of their program that provide digital literacy and inclusion. Discussion and possible action on commission scope changes and city open government initiatives. 11. (Rosenthal)

Commissioner Rosenthal stated that on December 8<sup>th</sup> the City Council approved an amended ordinance that enables this Commission (scope of work) which included, a technical clarification for the definition of community technology; removed this Commission's involvement with the evaluating the work of franchise holders; and added; advise city council on information and communications technology facilities and services that are operated by the City for public use, including the City wet site, Internet serves and open government technologies.

The City Council also passed a resolution in support of open government initiatives at their December 8<sup>th</sup> meeting.
