

**RESOLUTION NO. 20120112-064**

**WHEREAS**, in an effort to assess the impact development may have on Austin schools, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 20110303-036 on May 3, 2011, to create an Educational Impact Statement as part of a formal process for code amendments, policy proposals, and permitting for development and redevelopment projects within the Austin Independent School District; and

**WHEREAS**, the Educational Impact Statement can help guide future City planning and policy decisions by assessing a proposal's impact on children, families, and schools, including displacement of existing families and projections for future families with school-aged children; and

**WHEREAS**, the Educational Impact Statement was adopted in conjunction with the Austin Independent School District; however, six other school districts fall within the City of Austin; and

**WHEREAS**, redevelopment and new development also impacts planning for the school districts of Del Valle, Hays, Leander, Manor, Pflugerville, and Round Rock; **NOW, THEREFORE,**


**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

The City Manager is directed to consult with the various school districts within the City of Austin to extend the Educational Impact Statement to the other districts and, where there is interest, to take the

actions necessary to make the assessment a formal process for code amendments, policy proposals, and permitting for development.
