Additional Backup Information

This interlocal agreement between the City of Austin and the Austin Independent School District defines the responsibilities of each entity.

The purpose of the technology program is to produce students who upon reaching age 18 will be eligible to test for Texas Commission on Fire Protection (TCFP) firefighter certification and/or Texas Department of State Health Services (TDSHS) Emergency Medical Technician – B certification.

AISD will provide the instructors, classroom, curriculum material, and curriculum equipment for the Fire Technology Program. This will be for the first year students in 2011-2012 school year, and then for both the first and second year students in 2012-2013 school year. AISD will also provide transportation for Saturday skills days at AFD training facility.

The Austin Fire Department will provide qualified instructors for the second year student for only the 2011-2012 school year. AFD will also provide use of the AFD Training Facility and a training engine for a fee in accordance with

the fee schedule approved by the City Council.	
The initial term of this agreement is one year, and will automatically renew under identical terms for a one year term unless terminated by either entity.
