ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: The Art in Public Places (AIPP) Program is commissioning a work of art, inclusive of design, engineering, and construction that will serve as infrastructure in the form of a wall enclosing the Seaholm Substation. Artist, Nader Tehrani, was selected as the commissioned artist, and a professional services contract was executed with him on August 17, 2011.

The goal of the public art is to be a signature work of contemporary public art for Austin that is dynamic and visual engaging; strengthens the identity of the Seaholm District; enlivens the surrounding environment; contributes to a local regional and national contemporary art dialogue; serves a significant piece within the artist's oeuvre; and responds to the context of the Seaholm District 's architecture and programs.

Funding in the amount of \$33,447 is available in the 2011-12 Capital Budget of Austin Energy and \$17,018 is available in the Operating Budget of Economic Growth and Redevelopment Service Office for a total of \$50,465.
