Additional Backup Information

City Code Section 13-2-351 allows a maximum of four passengers per taxicab. During stakeholders and Urban Transportation Commission meetings, the issue of the number of allowable passengers on any taxicab vehicle was brought up by both the franchise owners and taxicab drivers.

Austin Transportation Department staff reviewed this request and recommends to Council to amend the code to increase the number of taxicab passengers based on the number of seat belts in the taxicab.
