Since 2007, many aspects affecting planning for a new HIV prevention plan have changed including:

- Dissolving the regional groups in favor of one statewide body;

- Need to broaden our approach in how we look at achieving our goals of reducing the transmission of HIV.

After five years of study, meetings, data collection, research, focus groups, healthy debate and writing, the Texas HIV / STD Prevention Community Planning Group (TxCPG) has created a plan which serves as a comprehensive roadmap for Texas. The Plan will be shared during this presentation.
