### Subject

Authorize award and execution of a 36-month requirements supply contract with STATEWIDE MATERIALS TRANSPORT LTD., for dolomite limestone crushed aggregate for the Street and Bridge Division of Public Works and the Aviation Departments used to minimize ice/snow build-up on streets in an estimated amount not to exceed \$120,000, with three 12-month extension options in an estimated amount not to exceed \$40,000 per extension option, for a total estimated contract amount not to exceed \$240,000.

## Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$20,000 is available in the Fiscal Year 2011-2012 Operating Budget of the Street and Bridge Division of Public Works and Aviation Departments. Funding for the remaining 30 months of the original contract period and the extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

# Additional Backup Information

This contract will provide for the purchase of an estimated 2,500 tons per year of dolomite limestone crushed aggregate for the Public Works and Aviation Department on an as-needed basis. This product minimizes ice/snow build-up on streets and eliminates the use of salt or sand during light snowfall or ice build-up. This supply agreement will help to ensure that dolomite limestone is readily available for required repairs and maintenance. The use of the dolomite limestone may not eliminate the need for salt or sand in extremely inclement weather conditions.
