AN ORDINANCE WAIVING CERTAIN FEES AND REQUIREMENTS UNDER CITY CODE CHAPTER 14-8, CERTAIN OTHER FEES AND REQUIREMENTS, AND AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF CERTAIN COSTS FOR THE CITY COSPONSORED 2012 SOUTH BY SOUTHWEST CONFERENCES AND FESTIVALS WHICH WILL BE HELD MARCH 9 – 18, 2012; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
