Prior Council Action:	<p>April 19, 2007 - Approved Resolution No. 20070419-026 directing the City Manager to evaluate and recommend strategies for limiting the use of non-compostable plastic bags by stores located in the City, and promoting the use of compostable plastic bags, recyclable paper bags, or reusable checkout bags.</p> <p>April 10, 2008 - Approved Resolution No. 20080410-048 adopting a voluntary plastic bag reduction plan in lieu of an ordinance banning plastic bags, to reduce by half the number of plastic bags entering the waste stream within 18 months.</p> <p>June 24, 2010 – Approved Resolution No. 20100624-079 directing the City Manager to determine the cost to Austin taxpayers of processing plastic bags in the waste stream.</p> <p>August 4, 2011 - Approved Resolution No. 20110804-021 directing the City Manager to draft, process, and bring forward for Council consideration by November, 2011, an ordinance providing a comprehensive phase-out of single-use plastic bags offered at retail check-outs within the city limits of Austin. The City Manager is further directed to engage retail stakeholders and concerned citizens in the development of the draft ordinance.</p> <p>January 26, 2012 - Set a public hearing to consider an ordinance amending Chapter 15-6 of the City Code phasing in a prohibition of single-use carryout bags within the city limits.
