He informed Council that Mr. Ehrler, Director of Parks and Recreation said depth finders can be used to locate objects and buoys can be placed where there is a hazard.

Councilmembers discussed the issue and R.L. Hancock, Director, Electric, Utility, explained the lake lowering procedure and the cost.
