Authorize award and execution of Amendment No. 1 to a 6-month contract with EMPLOYEE OWNED NURSERY ENTERPRISES LTD and ECOLOGY ACTION OF TEXAS, for continuation of the food service industry recycling pilot project for the Austin Resource Recovery Department for the remaining 6-month extension option in an estimated amount not to exceed \$37,142, for a revised total estimated contract amount not to exceed \$74,284.

This contract with Employee Owned Nursery Enterprises LTD, Austin, TX, And Ecology Action Of Texas, Austin, TX provides for the implementation of a food scrap recycling program ("Pilot Project") in several local food and beverage businesses (restaurants), for the City of Austin Resource Recovery Department.

This Pilot Project is to collect resource recovery data, evaluate the challenges and benefits of recycling in the food and beverage service industry, and provide local restaurants the opportunity to participate in a pilot project using local resource recovery and recycling service providers.

This contract was competitively bid and awarded in August 2011 (MA 1500 NA110000127). The recommended Council action is to approve Amendment No. 1 in an amount not to exceed \$37,142 thereby allowing for the continuation of the studies under this program.
